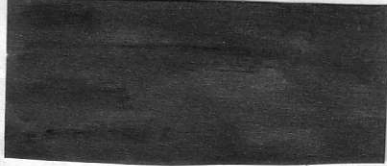

Thank you for writing to us about the above Penalty Charge Notice (PCN).

After carefully considering your case, and without prejudice to our position, we have decided to cancel this PCN.

This PCN was issued because the vehicle was seen parked on a waiting restriction marked by a yellow line.


Your vehicle was in controlled parking zone CC. Restrictions in that zone apply from 09:00 to 20:00, Monday to Sunday. There are signs at the entrances to the zone that show the controlled hours. Single yellow lines within the zone apply during the same hours as the zone, unless they have a separate sign showing different times.

I note your comments that you saw the time plate on the opposite side of the road and assumed that the restrictions would be the same. However, restrictions can and do differ on opposite sides of the road and motorists must check the restrictions at the exact location where they park.

Our records show that the time plate to which you refer is incorrect, therefore on this occasion only we have decided to cancel this PCN.

Please be advised that we consider all cases individually, and so other PCNs issued in similar circumstances may not be cancelled.
